

## Safety - ABCs of Fall Protection - Confined Space

Many workplaces contain spaces that are considered "confined" because their configurations hinder the activities of employees who must enter, work in, and exit them. A confined space has limited or restricted means for entry or exit, and it is not designed for continuous employee occupancy. Confined spaces include, but are not limited to underground vaults, tanks, storage bins, manholes, pits, silos, process vessels, and pipelines.

A confined space is an extremely dangerous place. Without proper training, workers face injury and death. The hazards of confined space can be dealt with by providing workers with the proper equipment and training.

Descent and rescue devices, such as FallSafe's Confined Space System, are an essential part of the fall protection program. They are used to retrieve or lower a fallen worker to the ground.
